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Sews All Fabric Types (kite-tail – jeans hem)	FABRIC: SELECT: USE: SEW: FABRIC: SELECT: SEW:	Medium Woven, Tricot Stitch Selector "A", Stitch Length 2.5 All-Purpose Foot Fold medium woven and tricot in half. Sew along the fold at 5/8" seam allowance. Denim Stitch Length 3.0 Fold denim in half (wrong sides together). Sew with fold at 5/8" seam allowance. Fold seam to one side. Topstitch down in place. Fold up raw edge twice to form hem. Sew hem in place.	 The HUSQVARNA VIKING® HICLASS™ E10 sewing machine will sew all different types of fabrics, without having to change the tensions. Electronic power provides a greater penetration even at slower speeds, whether stitching one stitch at a time or at full speed.
Easy Threading and Bobbin Winding	•	Show threading the top thread. Show where the bobbin is wound and point out the automatic bobbin stop. Notice the handy thread cutter on the side. The bobbin winder automatically disengages the needle for easy bobbin winding. The automatic bobbin stop prevents overwinding. (bullet and indent) Fold fabric in half with stabilizer between layers (next bullet) Mark the buttonhole position on the fabric

SELECT: Buttonhole Stitch I, stitch length -

Buttonhole setting

USE: SEW: Buttonhole Foot

- Snap on the Buttonhole Foot.
- Pull the Buttonhole Foot forward as far as it will go.
- When lowering the Buttonhole Foot, position the fabric so that the needle is on the mark that is furthest from you.

 To begin sewing the buttonhole, turn the stitch slection dial so that the picture of the buttonhole with a "1" next to it appears in the stitch display window.
- Set the stitch length dial to the buttonhole setting.
- The HUSQVARNA VIKING® HICLASS™
 E10 sewing machine will sew toward you,
 forming the right side of the buttonhole.
- Sew at a moderate speed until you reach the marking on the fabric indicating the bottom of the buttonhole.
- Turn the Stitch Selection dial so the picture of buttonhole with a "2" and a "4" appears in the stitch display window.
- As you begin sewing again, the HUSQVARNAVIKING® HICLASS™ E10 sewing machine will sew the lower bartack.
 Sew just a few stitches to form the bartack.
- Turn the Stitch Selection dial to the picture of a buttonhole with a "3" next to it and sew the left side of the buttonhole. Stop sewing at the mark at the end which is furthest from you.
- Turn the Stitch Selection dial back to the picture of the buttonhole and a "2" and "4" next to it. Sew a few stitches to form the top bar tack.

The buttonhole is repeated easily by using the marked lines on the foot as a guide. This is great when you are sewing many buttonholes of the same length. **Show a buttonhole sample.**

Seam/Overcast Stitches (Simulated Serging)





FABRIC: Sweatshirt fleece and ribbing

SELECT: USE: SEW: "G" on Stitch Selection dial, stitch length "S1" Satin Stitch Foot

- Fold sweatshirt fleece in half and cut a small curve
- Fold ribbing in half lengthwise, stretch and sew on as a neckline.

Sew the Seam/Overcast the edge at the same time. The Seam Overcast stitch prevents raveling of the seam allowance on a woven fabric and creates a seam that will stretch on knit fabrics.

SELECT: "F" on Stitch Selection dial

FABRIC: Wool

adjusting the guide on the Blind Hem Foot
